



Dear Customer,

On June 1st 2007, Regulation (EC) N° 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of December 18th 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was released and immediately became effective. It contains the following regulations:

- 1. From June 1st 2008, manufacturers and importers of substances as such, or of substances in preparations (mixtures) may have to register these substances with the European Chemicals Agency.
- 2. Suppliers of substances and preparations must provide the recipient with either a safety data sheet (Article 31) or safety information (Article 32).
- 3. Manufacturers and importers of articles/finished products which contain more than 0.1 mass percent per article of a substance on the "candidate list" needs to communicate with their users. This includes, as a minimum, providing the customer of the article the name of that substance.

Items purchased from Federal-Mogul Systems Protection are articles/finished goods which are not intended to release any substance under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Consequently, the obligations N°1 & 2 above are not relevant here & Safety Data Sheets are not available.

As required by obligation N°3 above, Federal-Mogul Systems Protection will inform customers if certain products contain one or more substances on the 'candidate list' in a concentration above 0.1% mass as soon as we become aware of the fact.
